







All VELUX skylights have been subjected to the same watertightness test as roof tiles.

The test involves installing the skylight onto a test rig at 27 degrees. A continuous large volume of water is fan forced onto the skylight - at 57 kph! The skylight is then turned at 45 degrees to the fan and the same volume of water and wind speed is applied. The skylight is held in each position for 2 minutes. During that time "there shall be no persistent dripping or streaming of water from any part of the skylight assembly, including flashings".

All VELUX skylights, roof windows and sun tunnels have passed the test and comply with AS4285.
